


Below is the screen you should see when first opening the camera. You can tell it is on the camera when the little silver dot is near the camera and not the video. As shown in the red box.



Camera settings

This will talk you through the different settings on the left hand side when using the camera. Have a look at theses settings and try a few out, feel free to get up and take some photos.

This button will change which camera you are using. Your tablet has one at the front and one at the back.



Shooting mode: these are the different types of photos you can take.


Single shot—Take just a standard photo.

Panorama— This will take a photo of a wider area around you but slowly turning left and right.

Buddy photo share— This is when you take a photo of someone face and you can tag them into the picture in order to share the image with them.

Smile shot— Once you have pressed to take a photo you simple point the tablet t them and it will automatically take a photo when they smile.

Timer: This setting will let you set a timer for you photos, this means if you set the timer for 2 seconds then when you press to take a photo, it wont take the photo straight away but in 2 seconds. **Try setting a timer and having a go.**





Effects: When you click on an effect it changes the colour of the image for example, black and white. Try taking pictures with different effects and see which ones you like best.



Contrast: This will change the brightness of the image, so you can make it the image lighter or darker, using the slider bar.



Have a play with the different settings and taking different photos to see the different options and things you can change!

Settings: This is the settings area for the camera.

Edit shortcuts— this setting allows you to change the different shortcuts on your camera screen.(the shortcuts are what have been talked about above)

Location tag— This will tag where the image has been taken, you can turn this setting on or off.

Self - portrait— This setting is another way of changing which camera you are using.

Scence mode—you can change the different scenes. For example, putting the scene to fireworks will mean you can take better photos of fireworks.

Resolution—this will change the quality of the image you are taking.

White balance— this allows you to set the camera for taking photos in daylight or cloudy conditions for better images.

Guidelines—this will add guidelines to your screen making in easier to get something in the centre of the image.

Voice control—having this set to one means you can take photos by saying the key words such as "shoot, capture, cheese"

Image quality—This is where you can set the quality of the image you are taking.
