

The best way to keep your tablet tidy and to be able to find apps easily, is it put them into folders on your home screen. This is a very easy thing to do. You will need to start by getting used to moving the apps around the screen.

Moving apps around

In order to move apps around you need to tap and hold the app you are wanting to move, you will then see the home screen will change allowing you to move the app around to where you want it. By moving your finger. Taking your finger off the screen will place the app.



When moving a app you will see a outline shown where the app will be places as shown to the left.



You can have more then one home screen you will see all you home pages at the bottom as shown left.

When pressing and holding a app it allows you to enter a sort of editing mode so you can also create folders, go the app info or remove the app from the home screen. These will options shown below will be at the top of the screen when you select an app.



Creating a folder

Creating a folder is a good way to keep all the same type of apps together, such as all the shopping app, games, ect. Creating a folder is easy if you follow the step below.

1. click and hold a app which you want to create a folder for.




Create folder
